

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-293

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BUILD DISCRETIONARY GRANT FOR THE DRIVE TO PROSPERITY: MANUFACTURING DRIVE/BLUFF BOULEVARD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) has formally announced the Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) Transportation Discretionary Grants program; and,

WHEREAS, The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2019 made available \$900 million for National Infrastructure Investments, otherwise known as BUILD grants. For this round of BUILD grants, the maximum grant award is \$25 million, and no more than \$90 million can be awarded to a single State; and,

WHEREAS, the Drive to Prosperity: Manufacturing Drive/Bluff Boulevard Reconstruction project is a surface transportation project that satisfies many of the selection criteria identified in the grant, including: located in a rural area, safety benefits, state of good repair, economic competitiveness, environmental protection, quality of life, innovation, partnership and demonstrated project readiness; and,

WHEREAS, project development including initial work required to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act and the National Historic Preservation Act has been done; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton City Administrator and Engineering Department are preparing a grant application to construct the Drive to Prosperity: Manufacturing Drive/Bluff Boulevard Reconstruction project; and,


WHEREAS, the total project cost is estimated to be \$26.5 million, with the BUILD grant application amount of \$18.5 million, and including \$8.0 million budgeted local and state funds; and,
